## INTRODUCTION

A smart appearance helps to maintain high esteem and a sense of pride in the school community. It can also be a significant factor in reducing instances of bullying. As a school, we expect all pupils to look their best.

The school uniform is compulsory. In preparing the uniform policy we have consulted with a variety of stakeholders, including the pupils.

## GIRLS

- Black formal school skirt (no shorter than knee length), or tailored trousers, **NOT** canvas, denim, corduroy or fashion trousers.
- Plain white shirt
- Grey V neck school jumper embroidered with the school motif
- Black blazer embroidered with the school motif
- Black, charcoal grey or white socks, or black tights
- Official school tie



## BOYS

- Black tailored school trousers, **NOT** canvas, denim, corduroy or fashion trousers
- Plain white shirt
- Grey V neck school jumper (including sleeveless option) embroidered with the school motif
- Black blazer embroidered with the school motif
- Black, charcoal grey or white socks. Official school tie



## ALL PUPILS

- Plain black footwear
- A dark-coloured coat or jacket (not a hoodie)
- Apron for Food Technology

## **PE KIT**

### **GIRLS**

- Green and black WHS polo shirt embroidered with the school motif
- Black shorts
- Black football socks/white sports socks

### **BOYS**

- Green and black WHS rugby/football shirt (reversible)
- Black shorts
- Black football socks/white sports socks

### **ALL PUPILS**

- All pupils need trainers or pumps (not black soles) and a towel
- Pupils are advised to wear gum shields and shin pads for all outdoor games
- Pupils are not to wear hoodies, coats, etc. during lessons. These items should be removed upon entering the classroom

### **STUDS/BARS/FACIAL PIERCINGS**

Governors appreciate the inherent danger in studs/bars being worn and so advise that only one stud in each ear will be allowed. Facial piercings, i.e. lip, nose, tongue or eyebrow studs are strictly not permitted.

### **MAKE-UP & HAIR STYLES**

No make-up or other form of ornamentation is allowed.

No extremes of hairstyle, including tram lines and designs shaved into hair, or inappropriate/unnatural colour, will be permitted.

### **GENERAL**

The Governing Body assume that if you choose to send your child to Welshpool High School then you are in agreement with our policies - parents and children do not have the right to 'opt out'.

Pupils are permitted to remove their blazer and/or school jumper in order to regulate their temperature in classrooms during lessons. Full uniform should be worn around the school building. However, during instances of exceptional hot or cold weather, the school may make provision to relax the uniform policy if it feels that doing so would be in the best interests of pupils. This will be at the discretion of the Headteacher and Governing Body and will be communicated to stakeholders accordingly.

All items of clothing should be labelled with the pupil's name.
